

Class Transfers Are Allowed

Transfers may be approved provided the class is scheduled, the judge is available, and the class has not reached its limit. Transfer requests will be accepted in writing (or email) to the Trial Secretary after close of entries until the day prior to the trial. Please confirm receipt of request.

Transfers made on the DAY OF TRIAL must be presented at the Trial Secretary desk at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Wait List

These trials have limited entry. The Club will establish a wait list to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to close of entries. All entries must have been received prior to the closing date and time. The Obedience Wait List will be held until close of entries. The Rally Wait List will be held after closing to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to Monday March 16, 2026 at 12:00 Noon. The full entry fee shall be refunded to an entrant whose entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry.

Notice To Exhibitors

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Trials. Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Trial Premium list.

ENTRIES CLOSE ON Wednesday, March 11, 2026 at 11:00 PM. Fees must accompany entries. Canadian Exhibitors MUST make all checks and/or money orders payable in U.S. funds. All checks and money orders should be made payable to Butte County Kennel Club or BCKC. See Page 2 for mailing address and information on emailed entries.

TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED and will be returned. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Forms and without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE. The Club assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent, or if the dog is entered in a class in which it is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. The Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. There is NO REFUND for duplicate entries or over-payments.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refunds of entry fees will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season after close of entries and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$8.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis

THESE CLUBS DO NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

JUDGING: The judging will start promptly as specified in entry confirmation. Dogs may arrive anytime prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. The Club will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class; it is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or its agent when the dog's presence is needed in the judging ring. Judges will NOT wait for any dog holding up a class.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS: Entries will be acknowledged after entries close, with acknowledgment and judging program sent to email address on entry. Should exhibitors NOT receive an acknowledgment within a reasonable time, contact the Trial Secretary.

DOGS IN UNVENTILATED VEHICLES: All persons attending this dog event hereby waive any claim for damages against the Schipperke Club of Southern California and the Butte County Kennel Club or their members or event officials, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

LOSS OR DAMAGE: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Trial. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor.

CHILDREN: It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the trial. Parents are expected to accompany and supervise their children at all times.

AWARDS: Trophies and prizes will be awarded at the trial. No Award will be mailed.

LIABILITY: The Schipperke Club of Southern California and Butte County Kennel Club will do all possible to ensure the welfare of dogs and exhibitors alike, but do not assume responsibility nor liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators at these events. In the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from a life-threatening condition, the owner/handler/exhibitor of that dog and owner of the vehicle waives all claims for damages against the Clubs.

CLEAN UP INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE RINGS: The rings are the responsibility of the exhibitors. Your cooperation in exercising your dog before entering the ring will be appreciated. Exhibitors are expected to keep the area around their crates and vehicles clean, including cleanup in any and all parking areas.

EXHIBITOR RESPONSIBILITY: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable disease, and have appropriate vaccinations.

NO SMOKING IS ALLOWED ON THE BUTTE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS.

Transfers may be approved provided the class is scheduled, the judge is available, and the class has not reached its limit. Transfer requests will be accepted in writing (or email) to the Trial Secretary until the day prior to the trial. Please confirm receipt of request. Transfers on the day of the trial must be presented at the Trial Secretary desk at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
