General Information

- **Bitches in season** are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$8.00 per entry will be retained. A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund
- **Clean-Up is Your Responsibility.** If your dog soils the grounds it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form for these dog shows you are agreeing that clean up is your responsibility. Violators maybe reported to the event committee for disciplinary action.
- **Special Attention.** No owner or agent shall allow his/her animals to be put in jeopardy of the elements. To do so may result in damaged vehicles during rescue attempts by the event committee.
- **COVID-19 Procedures** – All attendees are requested to follow CDC Guidelines regarding best practice measures and to adhere to any state, local or facility protocols pertaining to COVID-19 that may be in effect on the day of the event.

Grounds Information

These events will be held on private property. Please be respectful of the owners and their home and business.

- Park in the lot designated as RV parking. Follow those signs. Do not park by the kennel buildings.
- Clean up after your dog(s). Dispose of dog waste in buckets specifically for that purpose. Please do not use the garbage bins for dog waste.
- Dispose of garbage in containers placed on the show grounds.
- Only solid-bottom crates and wire crates with plastic trays are allowed in the covered arena where the rings are located. No Ex-Pens are allowed.
- Exhibitors may also place setups on the Lake Lawn area near by. All crates, mats or anything with a solid bottom must be pulled off the lawn at the end of the day. Nothing should be left on the lawn overnight.
- Do not allow your dog(s) to dig at the lawn or artificial turf areas.
- Absolutely no dogs or people are permitted on the dock or in the pool, including entrance and exit ramps.
- A food truck "Buckin Beverage Supporting Bree's Wing" will be available for coffee, snacks, and light lunch during the trial. Exhibitors may also bring their own snacks and beverages.
