

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW GROUNDS – FROM SAN FRANCISCO / OAKLAND. Take I-80 East to Vallejo. Take exit 33 to merge onto Hwy 37 West toward Napa. Take exit 19 for CA-29 North toward Napa, continue to follow CA-29. Turn right toward CA-221 / Napa Vallejo Hwy (signs for Downtown Napa). Slight right at CA-221 / Napa Vallejo Hwy. Slight right at CA-121/Silverado Trail. Turn left at Third Street



FROM SACRAMENTO AREA. Take I-80 West to Fairfield. Take CA-12 West toward Napa/Sonoma. Take CA-29 North. Turn right toward CA-221 / Napa Vallejo Hwy (signs for Downtown Napa). Slight right at CA-221 / Napa Vallejo Hwy. Slight right at CA-121/Silverado Trail. Turn left at Third Street.

FROM SAN JOSE AREA. Take Hwy 680 North to Cordelia. Merge onto I-80 East. Take Hwy 12 West towards Napa/Sonoma. Take CA-29 North. Turn right toward CA-221 / Napa Vallejo Hwy (signs for Downtown Napa). Slight right at CA-221 / Napa Vallejo Hwy. Slight right at CA-121 / Silverado Trail. Turn left at Third Street.

Day of Show Parking and Unloading, Grounds Information

- ◆ DAY PARKING ENTRANCE ON HWY 121.
- ◆ MOTOR HOME PARKING ENTER AT NAPA VALLEY EXPO RV PARK ENTRANCE ON THIRD ST.
- ◆ NO GROOMING SETUP OR X-PENS IN THE RINGSIDE WAITING AREAS OR IN THE BUILDING.
- ◆ CRATES ALLOWED AT RINGSIDE ONLY WHEN YOUR BREED IS IN THE RING.
- ◆ PLEASE SET UP BY THE RING ONLY 15 MINUTES PRIOR AND REMOVE YOUR TEMPORARY SETUP EQUIPMENT AND DOGS AFTER BREED TIMES TO ALLOW SPACE FOR OTHER EXHIBITORS TO SETUP DURING THEIR BREED TIMES.
- ◆ NO WHEELS ALLOWED ON THE GRASS IN THE OUTDOOR RINGS.

Additional Reminders

- **CLEAN-UP IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY. Exhibitors and Handlers** - If your dog soils the parking lot, show grounds or a ring, it is your responsibility to clean it up. Please police your grooming area before leaving the show grounds. By signing the entry form at this dog show you are agreeing that clean-up is your responsibility. Violators may be subject to a bench show committee hearing. Exhibitors, please, if you see an area that has not been cleaned up, notify a Club Member immediately. Thank you.
- **DOGS IN VEHICLES DURING HOT WEATHER** - All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against NCA, its Regional Club, Wine Country Kennel Club, and/or any of their members, in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions.
