

The Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch at a Specialty will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners' sex totals at least TWICE the number required for a five-point major, in the region in which the event is held. No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners.

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in single-entry, non-regular classes at this specialty. Full AKC registration is required (not limited registration).

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed or Variety competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. Winners of the above Non-Regular Classes may also compete in the Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any classes at this show.

SPECIAL AWARDS

Owner-Handled Best of Breed. This event qualifies for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS). The exhibitor MUST check the Owner-Handled checkbox on the entry form to be eligible. See Page 6.

Best Veteran Dog & Best Veteran Bitch, judged from the winners of the Veteran classes.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class. For Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Get only to be judged, based upon the merits of the Get. The get must be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular single dog conformation classes above.

Brood Bitch Class. Same as Stud Dog, substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "produce" for "get."

Brace Class. For two Newfoundlands with one common owner, to be shown by one or two handlers.

Maturity. Three dogs/bitches from a three generation pedigree, judged as a unit. See Page 8.

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace, and Maturity.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Brace and Maturity classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

National Owner-Handled Series



REMEMBER TO CHECK THE "OWNER-HANDLED" CHECKBOX AT BOTTOM OF ENTRY FORM.



The purpose of the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS) is to recognize and showcase the quality dogs being exhibited by owner/handlers that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

The handler must be an owner of record according to AKC's records as of the date of the show.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog.

Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition.

A professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may compete in NOHS.

Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.

Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler throughout the NOHS competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group/BIS competitions.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

Open to any Newfoundland six months of age and under **twenty-four (24) months** of age. All dogs/bitches must also be entered in a Regular class at this Specialty Show. Indicate "Sweepstakes" (stating age/class) in the space for "Additional Classes". Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular classes.

PRIZE MONEY

The Division of prize money will be as follows: 35% of the Sweepstakes Monies retained by the club for expenses. The remaining 65% will be distributed equally among the first place winners. Each participant will receive a participation rosette.

Best Dog in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best Bitch in Veteran Sweepstakes will be selected from the first place winners of the classes.

Maturity Class

This is a non-regular conformation class involving multiple-dog entries. Entry will be as one unit and is comprised of one dog or bitch from each generation of a three-generation pedigree. Unit to be judged on the merits of all three generations. Two of the three Newfoundlands must be entered in a regular or non-regular class at this specialty. Neutered and spayed are eligible. Dogs need not be owned by the same person(s).

An Official AKC Entry Form is REQUIRED for each of the dogs or bitches, plus the MATURITY ENTRY FORM (below) must be provided and accompany the official AKC Entry Forms. Please specify dogs oldest to youngest. Dogs may be entered in ONLY ONE Maturity Class unit.

CLASS TRANSFERS ARE ALLOWED in Obedience and Rally. Transfers may be approved provided the class is scheduled, the judge is available, and the class has not reached its limit. Transfer requests will be accepted in writing (or email) to the Trial Secretary from close of entries until the day **prior** to the trial. Please confirm receipt of request. Transfers on the day of the trial must be presented in writing at the Trial Secretary desk at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trial classes. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Event Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.

Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition

Judge: Mrs. Eva E. Berg

CLOSING DATE: Wednesday, October 22, 2025

ENTRY AND ELIGIBILITY

- ◆ Open to all Newfoundland puppies that are (4) months & under (6) six months of age on the day of the event. The class is not divided by sex.
- ◆ An AKC registration number or litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed, Miscellaneous or FSS breed.
- ◆ A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- ◆ Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- ◆ Professional handlers, members of their household and current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as **"Exhibition Only"** in the Four-to-Six Month Competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition. Please mark "Exhibition Only" on the entry form.
- ◆ Dogs that are owned or co-owned by the forenamed a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- ◆ Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.
- ◆ Exhibition Only entries may NOT be changed to be eligible to compete for awards after the close of entries.
- ◆ Use the Official AKC Entry Form from the premium list to enter. Indicate "4-6 mo. Puppy" on the entry form under "Class". The entry fee is \$27.00.

JUDGING

- ◆ All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition.
- ◆ Exhibitors should open their dog's mouth for examination.
- ◆ No dog is to be judged if it is brought into the ring bandaged, taped, glued or stitched anywhere including ears or tail. These dogs must be excused from judging but, at the judge's discretion, may return to be judged after the tape or bandage is removed.
- ◆ Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this Best Beginner Puppy in Breed.
- ◆ The judge will select Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy and BOS Four-to-Six Month Puppy. Exhibition Only entries will be judged as all other entries (examined and gaited) but may not be considered for BOB/BOS.

Notice To Exhibitors

1. Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks and for entering the same dog twice. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries received after published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
2. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
3. **AKC FEES.** The American Kennel Club requires each show-giving club to collect the following fees on each recordable entry and forward to AKC. Each first entry of a dog in conformation and obedience includes \$.50 AKC Recording Fee and \$3.00 Event Service Fee. Each additional entry of same dog in conformation/obedience includes \$3.50 Event Service Fee. Each entry in a Rally Trial includes \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee. Each entry in Four-to-Six Month Puppy includes \$2.00 AKC Recording Fee. No fees are collected for sweepstakes, junior showmanship or non-regular classes. The fees listed in the Entry Fees section already include these fees.
4. Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms, or photocopies with the agreement and rules on the reverse.
5. Dogs need to be at the show at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after being judged unless needed for further judging.
6. Dogs must be ready for judging. The Club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for and are not obligated to provide any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for dogs holding up class judging.
7. Dogs, which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.
8. No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those entered in the show. There are no provisions for unentered dogs.
9. Please note that **NO PUPPIES UNDER SIX MONTHS** are permitted on the show grounds, except those entered in the 4-6 Month Puppy Competition.
10. There shall be no drilling nor intensive training of dogs on the show grounds.
11. Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the schedule within seven days of the show, please contact the Show Secretary.
12. An **AGENT** is a person 18 years or older, other than an owner or co-owner, designated by the owner or co-owner to be handler of, and responsible for, the dog at the show. Agents' names may be followed by the initials which represent their AKC-recognized professional group affiliation or certification. Persons seeking the services of such an agent should familiarize themselves with the requirements for professional group membership or certifications.
13. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered the owner or his agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging. No trophies will be mailed.
14. **COVID-19.** All attendees will follow CDC Guidelines regarding best practice measures and will adhere to any state, local or facility protocols pertaining to COVID-19 that may be in effect on the day of the event.
15. **DOGS IN VEHICLES DURING HOT WEATHER** - All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against NCA, its Regional Club, Wine Country Kennel Club, and/or any of their members, in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions.




