Rally Trial Judging Program

PARKING IS LIMITED. Please do not arrive more than one hour before your earliest class. If your class is completed, your dog is not required for further judging, and the parking lot is near capacity, please leave the grounds to give parking space to another entrant.

RALLY EXHIBITORS ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY: Crating and seating **are allowed** inside the building. Space is limited. See Crating Rules later in judging program.

All judging will be held in Ring 1. No practicing is allowed in the ring at any time. A lunch break or 45-60 minutes will be taken at approximately 12:00 Noon each day. Judges may take additional breaks at their discretion.

Rally course maps will be available on the morning of each trial upon check-in. The start time listed is for the course walk-through. When a start time is specified as "After Noon", you can use the last stated morning time, then take into account the classes scheduled ahead of yours and possible absentees. Rally judging is scheduled at approximately 18 dogs per hour.

Additional Information for All Trials

- **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified **IN WRITING** no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained. A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.
- **CLASS TRANSFERS** may be approved provided the class is scheduled, the judge is available, and the class and judge have not reached limits. Transfer requests will be accepted in writing (or email) to the Trial Secretary until the day prior to the trial. Please confirm receipt of request. Transfers **ON THE MORNING OF THE TRIAL** must be presented in writing at the Trial Secretary desk at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the all judging.

Parking and Grounds Information

- **NO OVERNIGHT & NO RV PARKING** is allowed either during the day or overnight. RV's are not allowed on the grounds.
- **NO SMOKING** is allowed on the grounds.
- **VEHICLES MAY NOT BE LEFT IDLING** in the parking area.
- **PARKING IS LIMITED.** Please do not arrive more than one hour before your class. If your class is completed and the parking area is near capacity, please leave to give space to another entrant.
- **CLEAN-UP.** Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds. Potty your dog in dog run or on gravel driveway. Do **NOT** potty dogs on grass, plants, barn, equipment, side of building, or back of building. Do not allow your dog to potty within 20' of the building.
- **PLEASE KEEP DOGS QUIET.** If barking cannot be controlled, you will be asked to leave. Dogs must be kept **ON LEASH** at all times while on show grounds and parking areas except when being judged in the ring. Note: Farm animals and cats are present on property.
- **RETRACTABLE** leashes (flexi-leads) are permitted, but not to be extended beyond 6 feet in length in the building.
- Please stay away from the house area and respect owners' privacy.
- **NO FOOD VENDORS** will be available at this event. Exhibitors should plan to bring their own snacks and beverages. Fast food is available approximately 15 minutes away.
- **WATER:** Well water is available and safe to drink.

Rally / Obedience Crating Rules and Trial Procedures

- **RALLY** – Crating will be allowed in the building on Friday/Saturday only. Space is limited and you must crate between the red cones. A **CLEAN TOWEL** and/or **CLEAN MAT** must be placed under your chair and crate to protect the flooring and keep it clean. Please bring your own towel/mat. Spectators are allowed. No dogs on the couch!
- **No X-pens** in the building. **NO** crate aggressive dogs in the building. A dog not entered in the trial is not allowed in the building. There is room to warm up outside on the patio.
- Rally exhibitors may leave their crates overnight in the building on Friday night. All chairs, crates, and setups must be removed immediately at the end of the Saturday trial. The building will be emptied to be cleaned, equipment and furnishings moved out or rearranged, and two rings will be set up for the obedience trial on Sunday.
- **OBEDIENCE - NO INDOOR CRATING ALLOWED ON SUNDAY.** Spectator seating for viewing is allowed in the building. Space is limited. Chairs only will be allowed inside (bring your own chair). A **CLEAN TOWEL** and/or **CLEAN MAT** must be placed under your chair to protect the flooring.
- **Outdoor Crating** is allowed on the patio on the side of the building all days. Handlers may also work out of their car. Regardless of where handlers crate their dog, it is each handler's responsibility to know when it is their turn in the ring, and to be ready to go in the ring when it is their turn.
- **Exhibitor Check-In** will be in the building with the ring steward at the ring. There will not be a door monitor. Exhibitors and spectators will have access to the building during the trial.

- **FROM STOCKTON AREA** – From Hwy 99 take Hwy 88 (2 exits north of Hwy 4) to Brandt Road. Turn right onto Brandt Road going east towards the mountains. Cross Clements, take first driveway on the left.
- **FROM SACRAMENTO AREA** – Take Hwy 99 south to Acampo. Exit on W. Peltier (exit 270) and head east for 8 miles. Turn right onto Elliott Road for 3.5 miles. Elliot will become N. Tully Road as it passes through the town of Lockeford. Turn left onto Brandt Road. Cross Clements, take first driveway on left.
